For those guests who arrive to the venue earlier - excursion to the Main Building \Gallery of 19th and 20th Century European and American Art.

The Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts is the largest museum of foreign art in Mocsow. It was founded in 1912. In 1991 the Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts was added to the state register as the cultural heritage. The main museum building contains around 700 thousand items and includes a collection of casts from ancient statues, artworks, archaeological finds, a collection of objects from Ancient Egypt and Ancient Rome.

The Gallery was opened in 2006 and famous for the biggest collection of impressionists and post-impressionists out of France: Eugene Delacroix, Paul Delaroche, Philip Rousseau , Édouard Manet, Claude Monet, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Edgar Degas, Camille Pissarro, Paul Cézanne, Paul Gauguin, Vincent Van Gogh , Henri Matisse and Picasso.. The exposition of the art collection ends with the works of the second half of the 20th century, including representatives of the Russian avant-garde: Wassily Kandinsky, Marc Chagall, Giorgio de Chirico.

Price –entrance fee- 400 rub (6 euros\per person)- 1 building
