Personal, face-to-face, live meeting with the artist.

Andrei Volkov is an artist, a participant of numerous exhibitions in Russia and abroad, a curator of exhibition and publishing projects, a member of the Moscow Union of Artists, a participant of the parallel program of the 51th Venice Biennale. His works are in the State Russian Museum, Kolodzei Art Foundation (USA) and others. Being one of the most consistent representatives of radical abstraction among Russian artists, Andrei Volkov also belongs to a world-known creative dynasty. The collection of the Tretyakov Gallery contains the famous painting "Garnet teahouse" by his grandfather Alexander Nikolaevich Volkov, a famous painter and the founder of modern Uzbek art. His studio is on the top floor of one of the old buildings at the Moscow city center and place for meeting of intelligentsia.

“I want the viewer to perceive not just something reflected, the image in terms of mimesis, plot or style, but the reaction to simple manipulations with form and time — erasure and restoration. The viewer in the picture appears and disappears, becoming its accomplice. The meaning is the phenomenology of presence: of the painting as something given, of the author as a painter and a remover, of the viewer as an "agent of vision" -
